The Tallink Hotels Cup will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2018 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications and valid decisions of the ISU Congress 2018.

Participation in the Tallink Hotels Cup is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 1420.

BASIC NOVICE	age according to ISU Comm. 2172: before July 1 st preceding the event: has not reached the age of thirteen (13) Free Program 2:30 min.(+/-10 sec.)
INTERMEDIATE NOVICE	age according to ISU Comm. 2172: before July 1 st preceding the event: has not reached the age of fifteen (15) Free Program: 3:00 min.(+/-10 sec.)
ADVANCED NOVICE	age according to ISU Comm. 2172: before July 1 st preceding the event: has reached at least the age of ten (10) has not reached the age of fifteen (15) Free Program: 3:00 min.(+/-10 sec.) Short Program: 2.20 min. (+/-10 sec) Free Program: 3.00 min. (+/-10 sec.)

YOUNG 2001-2004	<u>born after July 1st 2001 - 2004</u> Free program 2:30 min ± 10 sec

- **REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES**

Entries for Pre-Chicks A, Chicks A, Cubs A, Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Chicks B, Cubs B, Springs B, Pre-Young, Young categories may be accepted by clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU. Entries must be submitted in an **online form** available at <http://www.tallinkhotelscup.com/>

### **Deadline of entries**

Preliminary entry forms must be submitted by **January 10, 2020** at the latest.

**Entries that are sent/received after the mentioned deadline will not be accepted.**

## Entries of Judges

The foreign club who enters 10 or more skaters is kindly asked to bring a Judge (of International category) to the Competition. It is also allowed to bring a Judge if the number of skaters is less than 10. Coaches are not allowed to act as Judges.

Entries of Judges must be made together with the entries for Competitors by filling the **Online Registration form**.

In case a judge is sent by a competitor/club, the latter is responsible for the judge's transportation expenses.

- **ENTRY FEE** (paid before January 14,2020):
  - 70 EUR** for the skaters with free program only
  - 85 EUR** for the skaters with short and free program
- **Late ENTRY FEE**(paid after January 14 and before February 1,2020):
  - 80 EUR** for the skaters with free program only
  - 95 EUR** for the skaters with short and free program

Each club has to pay 100% of the total amount for its participants right after the entry form confirmation, but not later than January 14, 2020. The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs. Entry fees are not refunded.

- ✓ We kindly ask the clubs to make **one payment** for all its participants.
- ✓ Please ensure that we receive the net amount of the required payment sum.
- ✓ All registration-related procedures (registration, annulment, changes) must be submitted to the Event Coordinator in written form.
- ✓ In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class. Entry fees are not refunded.
- ✓ Participating teams should inform of any changes in their team as soon as possible, but not later than **February 1, 2020**

- **AWARDS**

- Three first standings of each category/class shall be awarded with cup and a special price from **Tallink Group AS**.
- All competitors shall receive a diploma.
- Voucher for photos for each competitor.
- **The opening ceremony will be held on February 13<sup>st</sup>, at 19.00 in the Tallink Spa & Conference Hotel (Sadama 11a, Tallinn), where all the first day's competitors will be awarded.**

All other awarding ceremonies will be held at the ice rink approx. 1 hour after the end of their respective segments.

- **EXPENSES**

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

- **MUSIC**

Music will be reproduced from CD (audio track, formatted for music reproduction system – not computer). Music (equipped with the full name of the competitor, club and category) must be submitted to the announcer's desk before the relevant event and picked up from the same place after the event.
